PURPOSE:

This policy outlines Virginia Mason's participation in the Washington Death with Dignity Act as outlined in state law.

SCOPE: Workforce

POLICY:

Guiding Principles:

- Virginia Mason offers and recommends all medically appropriate treatments to patients regardless of their participation in the Death with Dignity Act.
- Virginia Mason supports all health care providers' individual choice to participate or to refrain from the process allowed by the Death with Dignity Act.

Participation:

- Virginia Mason will not allow patients to self-administer the medication(s) while in the acute inpatient or outpatient clinic setting.
- Virginia Mason will not prescribe the lethal medication at a Virginia Mason pharmacy or in the acute inpatient setting.
- Bailey Boushay House will allow patients to self-administer in the long term care setting.
- Bailey Boushay House will prescribe and dispense through the facility pharmacy.
- Virginia Mason health care providers may choose to participate in the process by fulfilling one or more of the following roles as outlined by in the Act:
 - Provide counseling
 - o Perform the duties of an attending physician
 - o Perform the duties of a consulting physician
 - o Prescribe the lethal medication(s) (outpatients only)
