



Intensive English Program Orientation

New students in the intensive English program have a three-day orientation to the program.

Day 1:

Students will go through the registration process. This includes turning in immigration and medical documents, getting a Georgia Tech ID card (Buzzcard), and getting a Georgia Tech computer account. Students will also take a placement test to determine what level they will study in the intensive program.

Day 2:

New Students will attend several information sessions to help them learn about being a student at Georgia Tech. Information sessions include the following topics:

- Safety
- Transportation on and off Campus
- Staying Healthy

New students also attend a welcome lunch, take a campus tour where they can see the facilities that they will have access to on campus, and visit the campus recreation center.

Day 3:

Students attend a two-hour information session about the intensive English program, important policies, technology assistance at Georgia Tech, and extracurricular activities. After the orientation sessions, student will have access to the orientation materials through Canvas, the Georgia Tech learning management system. Students will also have access to their class schedules through www.buzzport.gatech.edu and will be able to purchase their textbooks at the Georgia Tech bookstore.
