'Preparation and implementation of a course on the EU and on EU Cohesion policy for higher education institutions teaching journalism

Questions & Answers (Q&As)

You will find below a list of questions received for this call for proposals. Please note that the present document aims to complement and clarify the call for proposals and does not replace it. A Q&As document will be periodically published; applicants are invited to check this website regularly.

Q1. We would like to know if there are any limits given related to the length of the application to be submitted? We know that the overall application should not be larger than 25 MB including all relevant attachments. However, we would like to request if there is any limit given related to the length of the text or pages of the application itself?

A1. There is no limitation in the number of pages/words/characters.

Q2. We understood that the target group of the Actions under this call must be composed by journalism students, but is still possible for the course to address also people who are already journalists (Continuing professional education)?

A2. No. The specific objective of this call for proposals is to develop a curriculum and teaching materials for a course on the European Union and on EU Cohesion policy for journalism students.

Q3. Regarding the activities which must be implemented by the Action, we would like to better understand the following sentence "Deliver the course to journalism students as part of their study degree (in classroom or online)", on page 3 of the Call. Is it necessary that the curriculum created under the Action is also delivered during the Project Lifetime? Could it be fine to test it (as a pilot) in the 3 partner organizations composting the consortium and share it (its contents and educational resources) with a wider network?

A3. The specific objective of the call requires the potential beneficiary to deliver the course during the project's duration of between 12 and 18 months.

Q4. When the call refers to the "network" (e.g. in art. 2), is different from the "consortium"? E.g. we could have a consortium of 3 organizations but a wider network.

A4. Yes, the network can include more members than the consortium applying for the call for proposals.
